The Cultural Resource program provides safe and reliable access to Elders, traditional knowledge, medicines and ceremonies. The program serves to meet the needs of children, youth and families focusing on a wholistic approach to multigenerational healing and wellness.

The program facilitates and supports all aspects of cultural knowledge within the Friendship Centre.
